EC approved to make the modifications of its own by the University for an amount not exceeding Rs. 1, 80,000/- which shall be adjusted against the rent.

Hence the University desires to make the modifications on its own with an estimated amount not exceeding Rs. 1,80,000:- which shall be adjusted against the subsequent payments of rent. The owner has agreed for the adjustments with the rents payable.

Renewal of services of Multi-tasking staff (on contract).

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The period of employment of following Multitasking staff (contractual) expired on 19.09.2019. The services of the staff may be extended w.e.f. 25.09.2019 with an administrative break as given previously and as per earlier terms and conditions with minimum payment as per Government of Assam notification. (The matter was placed for discussion in the last meeting and a decision is pending). EC may advise the course of action.
