8	Discussion of purchase of Furniture & other small items:  The University is in the process of procuring furniture from Furniture house. The University is facing problem of comparing furniture made by different parties as they vary widely in terms of design, materials etc. Matter may be discussed and EC may suggest a modality. Similar is the case with other small items with small value.		Since University is facing problem in purchasing certain categories of items, the matter has been placed before EC for discussion. EC has suggested the following:  a. In respect of purchase of furniture and other items where there is no universal standard for comparison. University should follow the Clause 6.7 i.e spot quotation purchase given in Pg. No 8 of the Purchase Manual. Where University can make spot purchase up to Rs. 2lacs with the approval of competent authority i.e the Vice Chancellor subject to the availability of fund.  b. For other items there should be NIQ/NIT as per the Purchase Manual. In case of less than 3 responses the NIQ/NIT may be floated again for 2 <sup>nd</sup> time and if the response thereon is less than 3 again, NIQ/NIT may be floated once more. In the 3 <sup>rd</sup> NIQ/NIT even if single response is received single party may be selected without further NIQ/ NIT.  The bidder once bided need not response to 2 <sup>nd</sup> or 3 <sup>rd</sup> NIQ/NIT as their previous bidding will remain valid.  c. Once the University decides the brands to be purchased it may

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			directly order with the manufacturer or collect quotations from the authorized dealer in case of manufacturer does not supply directly with printed price and discount if possible. In case of multiple authorized dealers, in a locality, the quotation may be collected from 2 to 3 authorized dealers for competitive bidding.  d. In case of small items direct cash purchase may be made as per clause 6.4(iii) in the page 7 of Purchase Manual.
